



West Sussex County Short Mat Bowling Association - Return to Bowls

1. DO NOT attend any event if you are unwell or if you have not been booked in to play for this event – spectators are not allowed but additional drivers or supervision for juniors or special needs is permitted. On your arrival, please wait in your cars until the venue has been set up. You will then be asked to enter the building. Book in with the organiser, making sure they have your contact details. Follow the one-way system into the playing area and go to your allocated seating area in the hall.
2. Please make yourself aware of any Covid19 safety posters that are on display in the venue.
3. The dedicated toilet block is available via the left-hand side double doors which will be wedged open for ventilation. A socially distanced system is in place to access the single occupancy toilets and hand washing facilities. Sanitiser is also available in the playing area at the designated cleaning stations.
4. A team of helpers will be invited by the organiser to assist with the set up.
5. Face masks to be worn in hall communal areas. They are recommended but not compulsory in the hall when bowling.
6. Arrive at least 10mins before your event/fixture starts. Use the hand sanitiser in the entrance when entering the building. All four doors in the corners of the hall are to be wedged open for maximum ventilation of the building.
7. No money will be collected on the day. Players are requested to bring their own food and drink which is to be taken at their seat. Also please change into your bowling shoes at your seated area.
8. Weather permitting please take opportunity to use the outside areas whenever possible.
9. Covid-19 Safety requirements are on display at the cleaning stations please make sure you are aware of these requests and comply to them during your stay. Enjoy your visit to Westergate.

If you show Covid19 symptoms during or after you have attended a bowls session you must inform the event/fixture organiser who will inform the venues management. All players due to attend must have seen these guidelines and by attending agree to comply with these requests. Failure to comply may result in you being asked to leave the premises.
